**John 5:1-5**

<sup>1</sup> Sometime later, Jesus went up to Jerusalem for one of the Jewish festivals. <sup>2</sup> Now there is in Jerusalem near the Sheep Gate a pool, which in Aramaic is called Bethesda and which is surrounded by five covered colonnades. <sup>3</sup> Here a great number of disabled people used to lie—the blind, the lame, the paralyzed. <sup>5</sup> One who was there had been an invalid for thirty-eight years.

<sup>8</sup> Then Jesus said to him, "Get up! Pick up your mat and walk."<sup>9</sup> At once the man was cured; he picked up his mat and walked. The day on which this took place was a Sabbath,<sup>10</sup> and so the Jewish leaders said to the man who had been healed, "It is the Sabbath; the law forbids you to carry your mat."<sup>11</sup> But he replied, "The man who made me well said to me, 'Pick up your mat and walk.'<sup>12</sup> So they asked him, "Who is this fellow who told you to pick it up and walk?"<sup>13</sup> The man who was healed had no idea who it was, for Jesus had slipped away into the crowd that was there.
