Have You Ever Lost Anything That Is Really Important To You?

The One Thing:

Every Person Needs To Know That The Value God Places On The One Who Is Lost Is Priceless.

- **2 Peter 3:9** The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.
- **Rev. 3:20** Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me.
- Matt 5:14-15 You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house.
- **John 8:12** When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."
- **Luke 10:19** I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.
- **Luke 15:6** and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.'
- **Isaich 53:6** We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.
- **Zachariah 9:16-17** The LORD their God will save them on that day as the flock of his people. They will sparkle in his land like jewels in a crown.¹⁷ How attractive and beautiful they will be! Grain will make the young men thrive, and new wine the young women.

What Do We Need To Know From This Passage And The Other Parables in Luke 15?

- 1. Remember That Everyone Is Precious In The Lord's Sight.
- 2. Understand That God Looks For Those Who Are Lost. He Sent His Son "To Seek And To Save Those Who Are Lost." Luke 10:19
- 3. Therefore, Since We Are Precious Jewels To The Father, Son And The Holy Spirit, All Of Heaven Rejoices When The Lost Returns To God.
