Romans 3:27-31

## THE ONE THING:

Justification By Faith \_\_\_\_\_ Man By Excluding  
All Grounds Of Boasting, Therefore \_\_\_\_\_ Us To Be  
Saved But Still \_\_\_\_\_ The Value Of God's Law.

## KEY QUESTION:

What Implications Does Justification By Faith Have For Us Concerning  
Our Attitude Toward God, Ourselves, And Others?

1. It Excludes The \_\_\_\_\_ Of Man.

**Romans 3:27-28** Where, then, is boasting? It is excluded. Because of what law? The law that requires works? No, because of the law that requires faith. 28 For we maintain that a person is justified by faith apart from the works of the law.

2. Exclaims There Is Only \_\_\_\_\_ To God.

**Romans 3:29-30** Or is God the God of Jews only? Is he not the God of Gentiles too? Yes, of Gentiles too, 30 since there is only one God, who will justify the circumcised by faith and the uncircumcised through that same faith.

3. Establishes The \_\_\_\_\_ Law Of God.

**Romans 3:31** Do we, then, nullify the law by this faith? Not at all! Rather, we uphold the law.

A. Romans 8:3 For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a sin offering. And so he condemned sin in the flesh,

B. Galatians 3:21-22 Is the law, therefore, opposed to the promises of God? Absolutely not! For if a law had been given that could impart life, then righteousness would certainly have come by the law. <sup>22</sup> But Scripture has locked up everything under the control of sin, so that what was promised, being given through faith in Jesus Christ, might be given to those who believe.

**When We Accept That We Are Justified By Faith We Accept:**

**Romans 5:1** Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
